

TERMS & CONDITIONS FOR HOLIDAY BOOKING PRIZEGIVING

Please read these Terms and Conditions carefully before entering the competition. By entering you indicate that you accept these Terms and Conditions, and you agree to be bound by them.

1. **Promoter's Details:** TTSS Ltd (trading as Edwin Doran Sports Tours and MasterClass Sports Tours) is a company incorporated in England and Wales under number 125438936 whose registered office is at Platinum House, St. Marks Hill, Surbiton, United Kingdom, KT6 4BH.

2. **Eligibility:** This competition is open to schools in the UK, Republic of Ireland or the Channel Islands. We reserve the right to ask for proof of residence or eligibility. Employees and immediate family (defined as parents, children, siblings, spouse and life partners) of the Promoter or its affiliates, subsidiaries, advertising or promotion agencies are not eligible to enter this competition.

3. **How to Enter:** To enter the competition you must have completed an online enquiry form on the Edwin Doran/MasterClass website at - [Masterclass Request a Quote | Edwin Doran](#) - (the "Enquiry Form") – and duly submitted this to the Promoter (the "Enquiry"). The Enquiry must be for a school group trip with the Promoter's MasterClass brand, which must be for a minimum of 12 students, to travel on a MasterClass European Football tour (as displayed at [MasterClass European Football Tours](#)), to depart in either 2026 or 2027. The Enquiry must include all details which are required in the Enquiry Form. Only genuine enquiries will be entered into the competition. The Promoter reserves the right to request reasonable evidence from the entrant (or other representative of the school) confirming your role and eligibility (such as (but not limited to) organisational ID, website links, and/or documentation).

No entries from agents or third parties or entries automatically generated by computer will be accepted. Incomplete or corrupted entries will not be accepted. Entries will only be accepted if they comply with all entry instructions. Only one enquiry per school will be entered into the competition.

4. **Use of Data:** All details provided by you will be held by the Promoter and used in accordance with these Terms and Conditions and the Promoter's Privacy Policy available at [Privacy Policy | Edwin Doran](#).

5. **Dates:** The competition opens at 09.00 a.m. on 18 February 2026 and closes at 12.00 pm on 27 March 2026. All entries must be received by 11:59 am on 27 March 2026.

6. **Receipt of Entries:** The Promoter cannot be held responsible for network, computer or software failures of any kind, which may restrict or delay the sending or receipt of your entry. The Promoter is not responsible for entries not received and/or any lost entries. The Promoter reserves the right (in its absolute discretion) to reject entries and disqualify entrants, including without limitation where the Promoter has cause to believe that (i) there has been a breach of these Terms and Conditions or (ii) the entrant has interfered with the fair running of this competition, including without limitation by manipulating entries or the results, or has provided false information or has acted unethically in any other way.

7. **Prize(s):** Details of the prize for entering this competition are contained within Schedule 1 to these Terms and Conditions ("the Prize"). Anything which is not expressly set out in Schedule 1 is not included within the Prize. IMPORTANT: The Prize is not transferable. The Prize cannot be awarded to any person who, for any reason, would not be allowed by law to purchase or use the Prize. No compensation will be payable by the Promoter if the winner is unable to use the Prize as stated.

8. The Prize is provided by the sister company of the Promoter – Travel Class Limited (“JCA”) – and the entirety of the Promoter’s booking terms and conditions apply to the Prize, see [Terms & Conditions | JCA Adventure](#) (the “**Booking Conditions**”) for full details.

9. The trip comprising the Prize must be taken and completed by November 2026. The winner is not allowed to sell, transfer, or auction the Prize on to a third party and no alternative will be offered. The winner must review and comply with these terms and conditions in order to travel.

10. In the event that the Prize does not include transport, we strongly advise that you do not book any separate transport arrangements unless and until we have confirmed your booking. The Promoter shall not be responsible for, or provide any refund of, any transport arrangements that you book separately and prior to confirmation of the holiday booking. If you are unsure if the Prize includes transport then you should contact the Promoter.

11. The winner must ensure that they and their guests are not subject to any restriction which may impact their ability to travel. If you have any accessibility requirements, please inform the Promoter as soon as possible.

12. **Selection of winner:** The winner will be chosen at random from all valid entries of the competition on or around 16th April 2026.

14. **Notification:** The winner shall be notified on or before 24th April 2026 with instructions on how to claim their prize. The accuracy of any email address, address or phone number (as applicable, if provided) provided is the responsibility of the entrant. If a winner cannot be contacted or is unable to accept their Prize, the Promoter reserves the right to choose another winner from the eligible entries received. The Promoter shall make all reasonable efforts to contact the winner. Acknowledgement of the Prize by the winner must be received by the Promoter by 5.00 pm (GMT) on 28th April 2026. Should the Promoter not receive confirmation from the winner by this time, or in the event that the winner or substitute winner is unreachable or ineligible or declines to accept the Prize, or a substitute winner fails to acknowledge the Prize as specified by the Promoter, the winner or substitute winner shall forfeit the Prize and the Promoter reserves the right to award the Prize to another eligible entrant, picked by random from the remaining entries. The Promoter has no responsibility to anyone who has not responded in accordance with these Terms and Conditions.

15. **Winner details:** Details of the winner(s), surname and country of residence, will be obtainable after Monday 4th May 2026 by writing to the Promoter’s address specified in paragraph 1 above quoting ‘Winner: MasterClass JCA Sport Weekend competition’. The winner may be required to participate in post-competition publicity.

16. **General:** The Promoter reserves the right to amend the competition in exceptional circumstances. All entrants agree to abide by these Terms and Conditions and the Promoter reserves the right to exclude entrants for any breach of these Terms and Conditions. The Promoter’s decision is final, and no correspondence will be entered in to.

17. The Promoter may use photographs, names, ages and the town/city of the winner in future publications and publicity, and may require the winner to take part in promotional publicity as specified by the Promoter, including without limitation being filmed, interviews, photoshoots etc. By entering the competition, in consideration of the Promoter providing the competition and the Prize, the winner agrees to take part in such publicity and grants a worldwide, irrevocable, unconditional and royalty-free licence to the Promoter and all necessary rights and consents for the full period of any intellectual property

rights to use the winner's photograph, voice, likeness and/or image, and the name and age of the winner in any media without further payment or permission, for any future promotional activity.

The Promoter reserves the right to modify, suspend, cancel or terminate the competition for any reason, extend or resume the entry period, or change or withdraw the Prize at any time without giving advance notice and will do so if an event occurs that renders the competition itself or the awarding of the Prize impossible due to reasons beyond the control of the Promoter (including without limitation reasons which are unforeseeable by the Promoter at the time of running the competition) or if it cannot be guaranteed that the competition can be carried out fairly or correctly for technical, legal or other reasons and the entrant agrees that no liability shall attach to the Promoter as a result thereof.

The Promoter has arranged the competition in good faith but, to the fullest extent permitted by law, accepts no responsibility for and will not be liable for any claims, costs, losses, damages, expenses or liabilities, of any kind (including without limitation direct, indirect, consequential, incidental or punitive damages) arising out of or in connection with the competition or with the acceptance, possession, use or any other aspect of any prize awarded. Your legal rights as a consumer are not affected. Nothing in these Terms and Conditions limits or excludes the liability of the Promoter for death or personal injury resulting from the Promoter's negligence or for any damage or liability incurred by the entrant as a result of fraud or fraudulent misrepresentation by the Promoter or otherwise as prohibited by law.

21. These Terms and Conditions are governed by English law and the Promoter and the entrant hereby submit to the exclusive jurisdiction of the English Courts.

Schedule 1 – Details of the Prize

1 Prize

- 1.1 The Prize is supplied by Travel Class Limited (t/a “JCA”) which is a sister company of the Promoter.
- 1.2 The Prize is a 2 night stay at JCA’s Condoover Hall, for a JCA Sport weekend for up to 20 students and 3 staff from the winning school. Option to add on more attendees at a reduced rate.
- 1.3 The winning school can attend a JCA Netball or JCA Football weekend, on any of the 2026 dates advertised on the JCA website - [Junior Netball Weekends | JCA Adventure](#) or [Junior Football Weekends | JCA Adventure](#) – and is subject to availability.
- 1.4 The Prize includes 2 nights’ accommodation at Condoover Hall on a full board basis, in multi-bedded rooms for all 20 students and 3 staff. The students will be in multi-bedded rooms, with up to 8 per room but the Promoter and/or JCA reserve the right to change the room constitution. Staff will be in double share accommodation but single rooms may be provided to staff, subject to availability.
- 1.5 Includes fixtures and access to all activities on-site as included in the itinerary for the booking made for the Prize.
