

TERMS & CONDITIONS FOR LONDON PULSE PLAYER GUARD PRIZEGIVING

Please read these Terms and Conditions carefully before entering the competition. By entering you indicate that you accept these Terms and Conditions, and you agree to be bound by them.

1. **Promoter's Details:** TTSS Limited (trading as Edwin Doran Sports Tours), a member of the Travelopia Group of companies. Registered office: Platinum House, St. Mark's Hill Surbiton KT6 4BH. Registered in England with company number 06695822.
2. **Eligibility:** Only schools in England and Wales are permitted to enter this competition. Employees and immediate family (defined as parents, children, siblings, spouse and life partners) of the Promoter or its affiliates, subsidiaries, advertising or promotion agencies are not eligible to enter this competition.
3. **How to Enter:** In order for a school to enter this competition, the school must (i) film the school's netball team completing a passing sequence, (ii) post the recorded video on the school's Instagram account or the school netball team's Instagram account, (iii) tag @edwindoransportstours and @londonpulsenetball in the Instagram post (and ensure that the school is following both of those accounts, and (iv) use the hashtag "#PulsePassitOn" in the post.
4. No entries from agents or third parties or entries automatically generated will be accepted. Incomplete entries will not be accepted. Entries will only be accepted if they comply with all entry instructions. The school may only submit one entry to this competition. All entries will either be submitted for winning the First Prize or the Second Prize (as defined below) and it is not possible to win both. Once the First Prize has been drawn, any entrants into the competition before the First Prize was drawn, will be automatically entered into the draw for the Second Prize.
5. **Use of Data:** All details provided by you will be held by the Promoter and used in accordance with these Terms and Conditions and the Promoter's Privacy Policy available at <https://www.edwindoran.com/terms-and-conditions/privacy-policy/>. By submitting the school hereby represents and warrants that it has all required consent to share any personal data of any staff and/or students with the Promoter.
6. **Dates:** The whole competition period runs from 9.00 am on 23rd January 2026 and closes at 12.00 pm on 30th April 2026 ("**Competition Period**"). There will be a midway draw during the Competition Period, in accordance with the below, to award the First Prize. Entries from that point until the end of the Competition Period shall be eligible to win the Second Prize subject to these Terms and Conditions.
7. **Receipt of Entries:** The Promoter cannot be held responsible for network, computer or software failures of any kind, which may restrict or delay the sending or receipt of your entry. The Promoter is not responsible for entries not received and/or any lost entries. The Promoter reserves the right (in its absolute discretion) to reject entries and disqualify entrants, including (without limitation) where the Promoter has cause to believe that (i) there has been a breach of these Terms and Conditions or (ii) the entrant has interfered with the fair running of this competition, including without limitation by manipulating entries or the results, or has provided false information or has acted unethically in any other way.
8. **Prizes:** There are two (2) prizes available to be won for the winners of this competition,

the “**First Prize**” and the “**Second Prize**” (together, the “**Prizes**”), each as further defined and particularised below.

9. The “**First Prize**” is the opportunity for up to 10 school children from the winning school to be player guards at the London Pulse v Nottingham Forest match at the Copper Box Arena on 22nd March 2026 (the “**Nottingham Forest Match**”). The First Prize shall include 10 tickets for school children of the winning school to attend the Nottingham Forest Match plus an additional ticket for an accompanying member of staff. The winning school will be provided with a discount for additional tickets to be purchased for the Nottingham Forest Match.
10. The “**Second Prize**” is the opportunity for up to 10 school children from the winning school to be player guards at the London Pulse v LexisNexis Dragons match at the Copper Box Arena on 24th May 2026 (the “**LexisNexis Match**”). The Second Prize shall include 10 tickets for school children of the winning school to attend the LexisNexis Match plus an additional ticket for an accompanying member of staff. The winning school will be provided with a discount for additional tickets to be purchased for the LexisNexis Match.
11. The Prizes only include the ticket cost and the opportunity for the school children to be player guards at, as applicable, the Nottingham Forest Match or the LexisNexis Match. Any other costs such as (but not limited to) transportation and food and/or drinks are not included in the Prizes and shall be payable by the winners. Both the Nottingham Forest Match and the LexisNexis Match are not organised by the Promoter and the dates and locations of both matches are subject to change beyond the control of the Promoter.
12. Anything which is not expressly set out in these Terms and Conditions is not included within the Prizes. **IMPORTANT:** The Prizes are not transferable. The Prizes cannot be awarded to any person who, for any reason, would not be allowed by law to purchase or use the Prizes. No compensation will be payable by the Promoter if the winner is unable to use their Prizes as stated.
13. The winner is not allowed to sell, transfer, or auction either Prizes on to a third party and no alternative will be offered.
14. The Prizes must be used by the dates specified in these Terms and Conditions and in accordance with the pre-determined London Pulse home fixtures at the Copper Box Arena, London. The Prize may be subject to additional terms and conditions imposed by the Promoter (or London Pulse) or any other organisation in connection with this competition.
15. For the avoidance of doubt the winner of the Prizes are solely responsible for all additional costs and expenses associated with the Prize which are not stated in these Terms and Conditions.
16. The Prizes do not include any transportation or accommodation. You are strongly advised not to book any separate transport arrangements unless and until the Promoter has confirmed you are a winner. The Promoter shall not be responsible for, or provide any refund of, any transport arrangements that you book separately and prior to confirmation.
17. Selection of winner: The First Prize shall be drawn on 6th March 2026 from all eligible entries by a panel comprising of representative(s) of the Promoter and London Pulse to select a winner based on the content of the video uploaded to Instagram. Once that draw has taken place, any school that was not a winner will be considered for the Second Prize. Any entries after this date, until the end of the Competition Period, will be entered into the Second Prize

only.

18. The final date for submissions for the First Prize shall end on 5th March 2026, and the winner of the First Prize shall be notified on or around 12.00 pm (GMT) on 6th March 2026 with instructions on how to claim the First Prize. The winning school shall be notified by direct message on Instagram. If the winner cannot be contacted or is unable to accept the First Prize within 5 days of being notified, then the Promoter reserves the right to choose another winner of the First Prize from the eligible entries received. The Promoter shall make all reasonable efforts to contact the winner of the First Prize. Acknowledgement of the First Prize by the winner must be received by the Promoter by 5.00 p.m. on 11th March 2026. Should the Promoter not receive confirmation from the winner by this time, or in the event that the winner or substitute winner is unreachable or ineligible or declines to accept the First Prize, or a substitute winner fails to acknowledge the First Prize as specified by the Promoter, the winner or substitute winner shall forfeit the First Prize and the Promoter reserves the right to award the First Prize to another eligible entrant, picked by random from the remaining entries. The Promoter has no responsibility to anyone who has not responded in accordance with these Terms and Conditions.

The final date for submissions for the Second Prize shall end on 7th May 2026, and the winner of the Second Prize shall be notified on or around 12.00 pm (BST) on 8th May 2026 with instructions on how to claim the Second Prize. The winning school shall be notified by direct message on Instagram. If the winner cannot be contacted or is unable to accept the Second Prize within 5 days of being notified, then the Promoter reserves the right to choose another winner of the Second Prize from the eligible entries received. The Promoter shall make all reasonable efforts to contact the winner of the Second Prize. Acknowledgement of the Second Prize by the winner must be received by the Promoter by 5.00 p.m. on 13th May 2026. Should the Promoter not receive confirmation from the winner by this time, or in the event that the winner or substitute winner is unreachable or ineligible or declines to accept the Second Prize, or a substitute winner fails to acknowledge the Second Prize as specified by the Promoter, the winner or substitute winner shall forfeit the Second Prize and the Promoter reserves the right to award the Second Prize to another eligible entrant, picked by random from the remaining entries. The Promoter has no responsibility to anyone who has not responded in accordance with these Terms and Conditions.

Winner details: Details of the winning school will be obtainable after Monday 9th March 2026 (for the First Prize) and Monday 11th May 2026 (for the Second Prize) by writing to the Promoter's address specified in paragraph 1 above quoting '**Winner: LONDON PULSE PLAYER GUARDS**'. The winners of the Prizes may be required to participate in post-competition publicity.
21. The Promoter reserves the right to amend the competition in exceptional circumstances. All entrants agree to abide by these Terms and Conditions and the Promoter reserves the right to exclude entrants for any breach of these Terms and Conditions. The Promoter's decision is final, and no correspondence will be entered in to.
22. The Promoter may use photographs, names, ages and the town/city of the winner in future publications and publicity, and may require the winner to take part in promotional publicity as specified by the Promoter, including without limitation being filmed, interviews, photoshoots etc. By entering the competition, in consideration of the Promoter providing the competition and the Prize, the winner agrees to take part in such publicity and grants a worldwide, irrevocable, unconditional and royalty-free licence to the Promoter and all necessary rights and consents for the full period of any intellectual property rights to use the school's photograph, voice, likeness and/or image, and the name and age of

the winner in any media without further payment or permission, for any future promotional activity.

The Promoter reserves the right to modify, suspend, cancel or terminate the competition for any reason, extend or resume the entry period, or change or withdraw the Prize at any time without giving advance notice and will do so if an event occurs that renders the competition itself or the awarding of the Prize impossible due to reasons beyond the control of the Promoter (including without limitation reasons which are unforeseeable by the Promoter at the time of running the competition) or if it cannot be guaranteed that the competition can be carried out fairly or correctly for technical, legal or other reasons and the entrant agrees that no liability shall attach to the Promoter as a result thereof.

The Promoter has arranged the competition in good faith but, to the fullest extent permitted by law, accepts no responsibility for and will not be liable for any claims, costs, losses, damages, expenses or liabilities, of any kind (including without limitation direct, indirect, consequential, incidental or punitive damages) arising out of or in connection with the competition or with the acceptance, possession, use or any other aspect of any prize awarded.
